



## **On identifying of instances when foreign nationals or stateless persons temporarily staying (temporarily resident) in the Russian Federation perform work outside region of the Russian Federation in which they were issued a work permit (temporary residence permit)**

In accordance with article 13, paragraph 6 of Federal Law “On the legal status of foreign nationals in the Russian Federation” Government of Russia has established instances when foreign national (stateless person) temporarily staying or temporary residing in Russia can perform work outside region of the Russian Federation in which they were issued work permit or temporary residence permit.

### **1) Business trip**

- ✓ If foreign national temporarily staying in Russia is sent on a business trip, the total duration of work outside the stated region can not exceed 10 calendar days within the validity of work permit.
- ✓ If foreign national temporarily residing in Russia is sent on a business trip, the total duration of work outside the stated region can not exceed 40 calendar days within 12 calendar months.

### **2) Regular employment includes traveling or field work and this is stipulated in labor contract**

- ✓ If foreign national temporarily staying in Russia complies with the above condition, the total duration of work outside stated region can not exceed 60 calendar days within the validity of work permit.
- ✓ If foreign national temporarily residing in Russia complies with the above condition, the total duration of work outside stated region is 90 calendar days within 12 calendar months.

The list of positions and works is established by authorized state bodies.

## **On the issue of medical certificates confirming absence of diseases**

On the 15<sup>th</sup> of January Government Decree №681 “On the issue order of work permits for foreign nationals temporarily working in the Russian Federation” dated 15<sup>th</sup> November, 2006 took force. In accordance with stated Decree employer is obliged to provide authorized migration authorities with special medical certificates confirming absence of leprosy, syphilis, tuberculosis, lymphogranuloma, shancroid, HIV and moreover drug addiction.

Starting 26<sup>th</sup> March, 2007 state bodies issuing work permits accept the abovementioned medical certificates only from medical clinics which are approved by Order of health protection department N 477 “On the temporary medical check-ups of foreign nationals and stateless persons who obtain temporary residence permit, residence permit or work permit in the Russian Federation”.
